ABOUT INNOVATORS CONCLAVE 2026

Innovators Conclave 2026 is where India's next builders meet the people who can back them. The 2nd edition runs across 24–25 October 2026 at JNTU Anantapuram. The shift from Hyderabad to Rayalaseema is deliberate. While India's talent has always been distributed, the capital, the mentorship, and the platforms have not. On that note, India's innovation pipeline cannot keep ending in six metros.

IC 2026 closes the gap by going to where the builders already are.

THE CONCLAVE IS BUILT TO:

- Bring student founders, school innovators, and early-stage builders into the same room as mentors, investors, and industry leaders.
- Introduce school students from Class 6 to Class 10 to a national innovation platform through the School Innovation Expo.
- Convene Strategic Dialogues With founders, policy leaders, and capital partners on what India's next innovation decade should look like.

THE HACKATHON

36 hours. ₹9 Lakhs in prizes. Five sectors — AgriTech & Supply Chain, EdTech AI/ML, HealthTech & BioTech, Smart Cities & Civil Tech, Sustainability & Climate Action. Problem statements drop on Day 1.



STRATEGIC DIALOGUES

Keynotes and panels with founders, capital partners, and policy voices. The conversation happens on the floor in the room.



STARTUP EXPO

20 stalls. Selection only. The teams investors and incubators came to evaluate up close.



SCHOOL INNOVATION EXPO

A protected national platform for Class 6 to Class 10 students. Founders are made earlier than people think.



MENTORSHIP TRACKS

50+ mentors across the five hackathon sectors. Structured one-on-one time built into the agenda.



THE PITCH FLOOR

30 minutes per startup. 10 to present, 10 for Q&A, 10 for roadmap guidance. Backed by BITS TBI, Ratan Tata Innovation Hub, and A-Hub.



WHY ANANTAPUR. WHY NOW.

India is on track to become the world's third-largest economy. The harder question is who builds it, and from where. The answer cannot be six metros. Anantapur sits in Rayalaseema — a region with engineering talent, industrial corridors, and almost no innovation infrastructure pointed at it. IC 2026 is here on purpose.



WHY ANANTAPUR MAKES STRATEGIC SENSE:

01 JNTU Anantapuram has produced engineers for decades.

02 **Credible and Institutional Support**
The Andhra Pradesh Economic Development Board and AP State Skill Development Corporation as partners on the ground.

03 **Solving problems where it matters.**
Climate, agri, civil infrastructure, and rural healthtech rarely get built well from a Bangalore office.

04 **Geographical Proximity** from the StartUp Hub of Bangalore. Anantapur is roughly two hours from Bangalore by rail. The investor isn't far. The story usually is.

THE CONCLAVES LIVES HERE.

The Hackathon and The Pitch Floor are where the conclave does its load-bearing work. One produces builders. The other connects them to capital. Together they're the spine.

THE HACKATHON



36 hours. Five sectors. ₹9 Lakhs in prize capital.

Teams pick a sector, take a problem statement that drops on Day 1, and build a working prototype against it. The whole thing happens on the floor at JNTU Anantapuram, in front of mentors and evaluators, with no online round.



The five sectors. AgriTech and Supply Chain. EdTech and AI/ML. HealthTech and BioTech. Smart Cities and Civil Tech. Sustainability and Climate Action. Each sector has a problem statement written by someone working in it.



How it's evaluated. Three weighted rounds — Idea and Solution Presentation (15%), Prototype Development and Integration (35%), Final Demo and Market Readiness (50%).



Three independent evaluators per round. **The scoring is weighted toward execution because shipping is the proof.**



What's at stake. ₹9 Lakhs in prize capital across the five sectors. Sector winners move directly onto The Pitch Floor for incubator evaluation. The Hackathon is the entry point into the rest of the IC pipeline.



THE PITCH FLOOR



30 minutes per startup. Up to ₹1.2 Crores in seed funding. Every selected startup gets 30 minutes — 10 to present, 10 for Q&A, 10 for roadmap guidance. The point is mentorship, not theatre.



Who's running it. BITS TBI, Ratan Tata Innovation Hub, and A-Hub run the floor on the ground. Pre-screened incubation partners and angels come specifically to evaluate.



What's available. Up to ₹1.2 Crores in milestone-based seed funding through partner incubators. Selection happens through the Pitch Floor process, not on stage.



What happens after. Selected founders move into incubation pipelines after the event. The conversation continues past the conclave.

SHOWCASE YOUR WORK HERE.

The Startup Expo and the School Innovation Expo run in parallel through both days. One is for the founders the room came to evaluate. The other is for the founders the room hasn't met yet.



THE STARTUP EXPO



20 stalls. Selection only. The Startup Expo holds 20 stalls across the IC floor, each one a startup the selection panel decided was ready to be in front of investors and incubators.



Why selection-only. A 20-stall format means every conversation between a startup and a buyer happens because both sides chose to have it.



Who's there to evaluate.

The same incubators, angel investors, and corporate innovation teams running The Pitch Floor. The Startup Expo gives them a second venue to revisit teams they shortlisted.



What founders walk away with.

Direct meetings with backers actively writing cheques in 2026. Continued access to the IC alumni network beyond the two days.



THE SCHOOL INNOVATION EXPO



A protected national platform for Class 6 to Class 10 students. This brings school students onto the IC floor while they're still building the curiosity. Founders are made earlier than people think.



Who can apply. Class 6 to Class 10 students from any school. Government, private, residential, low-resource selection is on the project, not the institution.



The format. Dedicated section of the conclave floor. Each project gets a stall, a 10-minute panel slot, and structured mentorship from the IC mentor pool. Students compete with each other in age-appropriate categories.



Why this exists. India is going to need 10x the founder pipeline it currently produces. The School Innovation Expo is IC's bet on what an early-stage platform looks like when it's pointed six years upstream.

CONVERSATIONS THAT EXTEND BEYOND THE PITCH.



The Strategic Dialogues and Mentorship Tracks are the connective tissue. They're what turns a two-day event into a two-day system.

Sessions selected for substance over headline value. Keynotes and panels with state leadership, founders who have built through cycles, capital partners, and policy voices. The audience is in the room with them — there is no green-room separation between speaker and floor.

What's covered. India's clean-energy transition. The capital landscape for deep-tech outside metros. State-level innovation policy and how founders should read it. The future of Indian R&D infrastructure.

Who shapes the agenda. Topics are picked by the IC programme committee in consultation with state partners and the incubator ecosystem. Sessions are kept tight on purpose — 30 to 45 minutes each, with structured Q&A.

50+ mentors. Slots booked in advance. Mentors come briefed. Founders book slots with sector-relevant mentors before the conclave begins. Mentors arrive having read the founder's one-pager.

The sectors. AgriTech, EdTech, HealthTech, Smart Cities, Sustainability, and Aerospace. Each track has 8 to 12 mentors with first-hand operating or investing experience in that vertical.

The format. Structured short-form sessions — typically 20 minutes per founder-mentor pair. Founders can book up to four sessions across the two days. Follow-up introductions happen through the IC alumni network post-event.

THE FLOOR IS BUILT AROUND NINE KINDS OF PEOPLE.

7,000+ innovators, builders, and decision-makers across the IC floor.

The hardest part of building a startup in India isn't the idea. It's the access.

The access to the right investor for your sector. An appropriate mentor who's solved your specific problem before. The specific incubator running a programme that fits your stage. The existence of all these people in the same building is a rarity. For two days at IC 2026, they are.

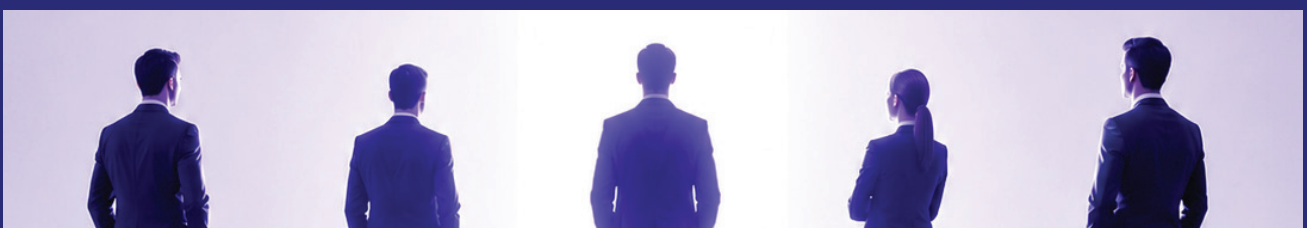

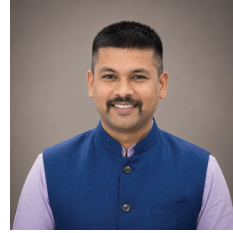

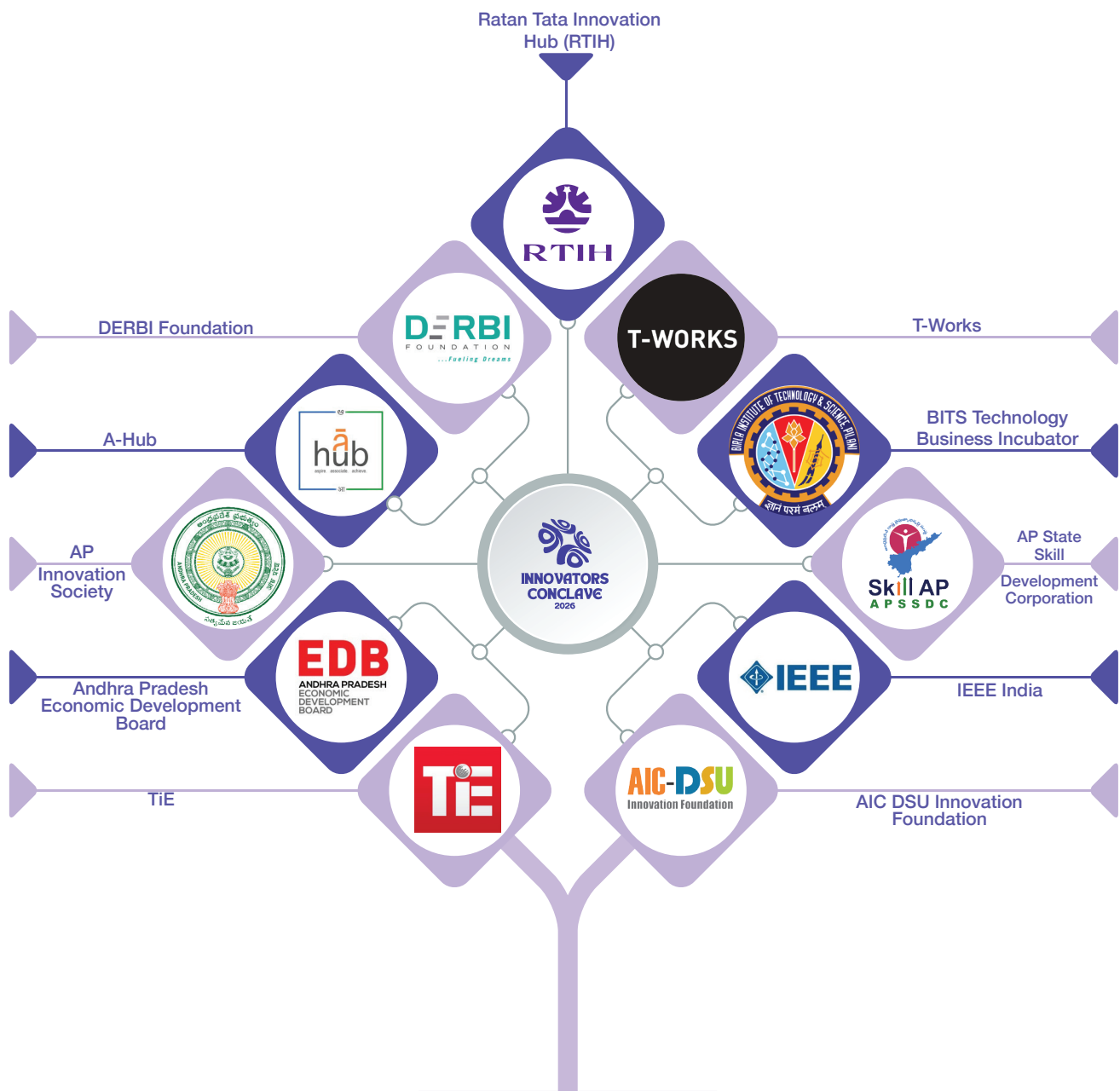
